



2009 B.C. Apple Review

All varieties reported are BCTF fresh sales only and do not represent Provincial production, nor include process sales.

A late-season freeze impacted a number of varieties that had not yet been harvested (including Red Delicious, Fuji, and Gr. Smith). The reduction in these varieties and a small amount of hail has led to a decrease in the overall crop volume this season. After last year's abundance of small sizes, the 2009 crop has returned to a more 'normal' size profile. Ambrosia continues to perform well and is being well-received into the marketplace.
