Dedicated to Sustainability

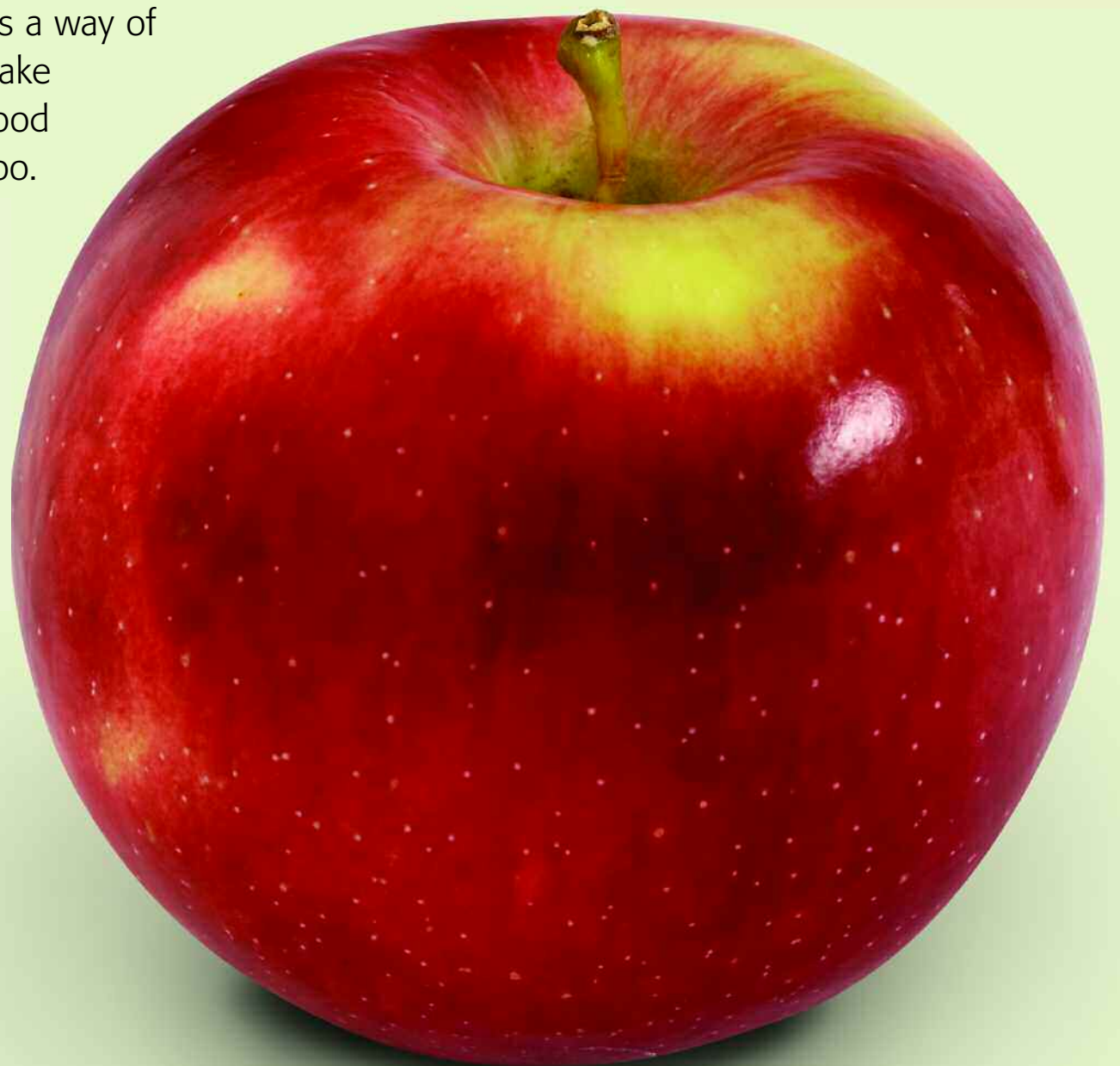
Through a process called Integrated Fruit Production (IFP), Canadian apple growers are committed to keeping apple farming a sustainable industry.
